ASIA REGIONAL HIGHER EDUCATION SUMMIT COMMENCES IN DHAKA

DHAKA, OCTOBER 5 -- Representatives of universities, businesses, foundations and governments from across Asia are gathering in Dhaka October 6-8 for the Asia Regional Higher Education Summit entitled "Higher Education's Responses to Global Challenges."

This Asia Regional Higher Education Summit is sponsored by the United States Government through the U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID) and co-hosted by the University of Dhaka and the Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology. This Summit is a follow-up to the Global Higher Education Summit recently held in Washington, DC. The Washington summit was convened by Secretary of State Condoleezza Rice, Secretary of Education Margaret Spellings, and USAID Administrator and Director of U.S. Foreign Assistance Henrietta Fore. The Summit's objective was to expand the role and impact of U.S. and foreign higher education institutions in worldwide social and economic development.
